## BARANGAROO COMMUNITY

The Blackmores Sydney Running Festival boasts over 33,000 participants from 66 countries to run, walk or jog in one of the stunning events which gives participants the unique opportunity to cross the iconic Sydney Harbour Bridge traffic free and take in Sydney's spectacular sights through our beautiful city and surrounding suburbs.

The Blackmores Sydney Marathon course is a flat, fast and scenic route. The Marathon continues to hold the prestigious top honour of the International Association of Athletics Federation (IAAF) Road Race Gold Label Status – recognising the event alongside the big cities of marathons such as London, Boston and New York. It is also the only Australian running event that is broadcast live. The event has raised over \$16.9 million for local charities and will contribute over \$11,000,000 to the local economy.

## IMPORTANT ROAD CLOSURES & SPECIAL EVENT CLEARWAY INFORMATION

There will be road closures in place along the 42km course in North Sydney, the Sydney CBD, The Rocks, Walsh Bay, Barangaroo, Pyrmont, Darlinghurst, Moore Park and Centennial Park on Sunday 17 September 2017 between 4:00am and 1:30pm. To help minimise traffic congestion, to create a course for the 4 running events (Marathon, Half Marathon, 10k Bridge Run and Family Fun Run) and to ensure, where possible, hotel guests, employees, business owners and residents are able to gain access to these areas where possible.

The 2017 Blackmores Sydney Running Festival ROAD CLOSURES IN YOUR AREA flyer is enclosed with this letter, please take the time to familiarise yourself with this information so you can plan ahead.

The road closures specific to your area include;

<b>Sydney CBD West: 4:00AM – 12MIDDAY</b>		
Erskine Street	Between Shelley Street and Kent Street	Both directions
Kent Street	Between Napoleon Street and Erskine Street	Southbound
Napoleon Street	Between Kent Street and Sussex Street	Both directions
Wheat Road Off Ramp*	Between Harbour St and Wheat Road	Northbound
*Access to Wheat Road for Cockle Bay Wharf tenants, King Street Wharf tenants/residents and Barangaroo South tenants/residents will be via a traffic control arrangement on Harbour Street at Day Street. Exiting the area will be via a two way traffic control on Wheat Road between 6:15am – 11:30am.		

<b>Walsh Bay &amp; Barangaroo: 4:00AM – 1:30PM</b>		
Barangaroo Avenue	Between Lime Street and Watermans Quay	Both directions
Dalgety Road	Between Windmill Street and Towns Place	Northbound
Hickson Road	Between Napoleon Street and Park Hyatt Sydney	Both directions
Towns Place	Between Barangaroo Avenue and Hickson Road	Both directions
Watermans Quay	Between Barangaroo Avenue and Hickson Road	Both directions

Even though there are road closures in your area please note the following;

- Access to Cockle Bay, King Street Wharf and Barangaroo South for residents, tenants and businesses will be maintained for the duration of the road closures.
- Between 4:00am – 6:15am** access will be via Wheat Road northbound. Vehicles will need to **exit the area via Erskine Street** which will remain as a crossover point within the road closures for vehicles between Shelley Street and Kent Street **until 6:15am.**
- Between 6:15am – 11:30am access into and out of the area** will be **via Wheat Road.** Please note that there will be a contraflow traffic arrangement in place meaning that the vehicles will also be exiting the area via Wheat Road and back towards Harbour Street at Day Street.

- Access to Barangaroo Avenue is for **Local Access Only**. Tenants and Residents will be permitted access into and out Barangaroo Avenue to access the car park on Barangaroo Avenue only at Lime Street.
- Please note that **there is no through access northbound on Barangaroo Avenue past the car park.**
- Vehicles will be escorted through the road closures by Traffic Controllers or NSW Police where required and are to follow their instructions at all times.
- There will be **no access into Watermans Quay** from Barangaroo Ave during the road closure times.
- There will be **no access into/out of the car park onto Watermans Quay** during the road closure times.
- There will be **no access into/out of the car park onto Hickson Road opposite Napoleon Street** between 4:00am – 11:30am.
- Vehicles will be permitted to **exit the car park from the exit onto Sussex Street only** southbound on Sussex Street or towards Napoleon Street **from 11:30am.**

We also ask that **International Towers Sydney** help to lockdown the course routes from vehicles during the **road closure times of 4:00am – 1:30pm** by locking their garage doors and to ensure vehicles cannot appear on the course while the event is taking place as we want to ensure that vehicles are not mixing with the event participants on the course routes.
