

## Monthly Update – Barangaroo

October 2017

Sydney Metro is Australia’s largest public transport project. It will transform Sydney, delivering more trains and faster services for customers across the network.

Sydney Metro City & Southwest extends the new metro network from the end of the Sydney Metro Northwest at Chatswood, under Sydney Harbour, through new railway stations in the CBD and west to Bankstown – a total of 66 kilometres of metro rail.

When services start in 2024, there will be a train at least every four minutes in the peak – customers won’t need a timetable, they’ll just turn up and go.

The \$2.81 billion contract for tunnelling and station excavation works was awarded to John Holland CPB Ghella Joint Venture on 22 June 2017.

### Early works – Barangaroo Station site

Early works will commence at the Barangaroo Station site and Millers Point during the month of **October 2017**. The following activities will be undertaken, weather and site conditions permitting (see map overleaf).

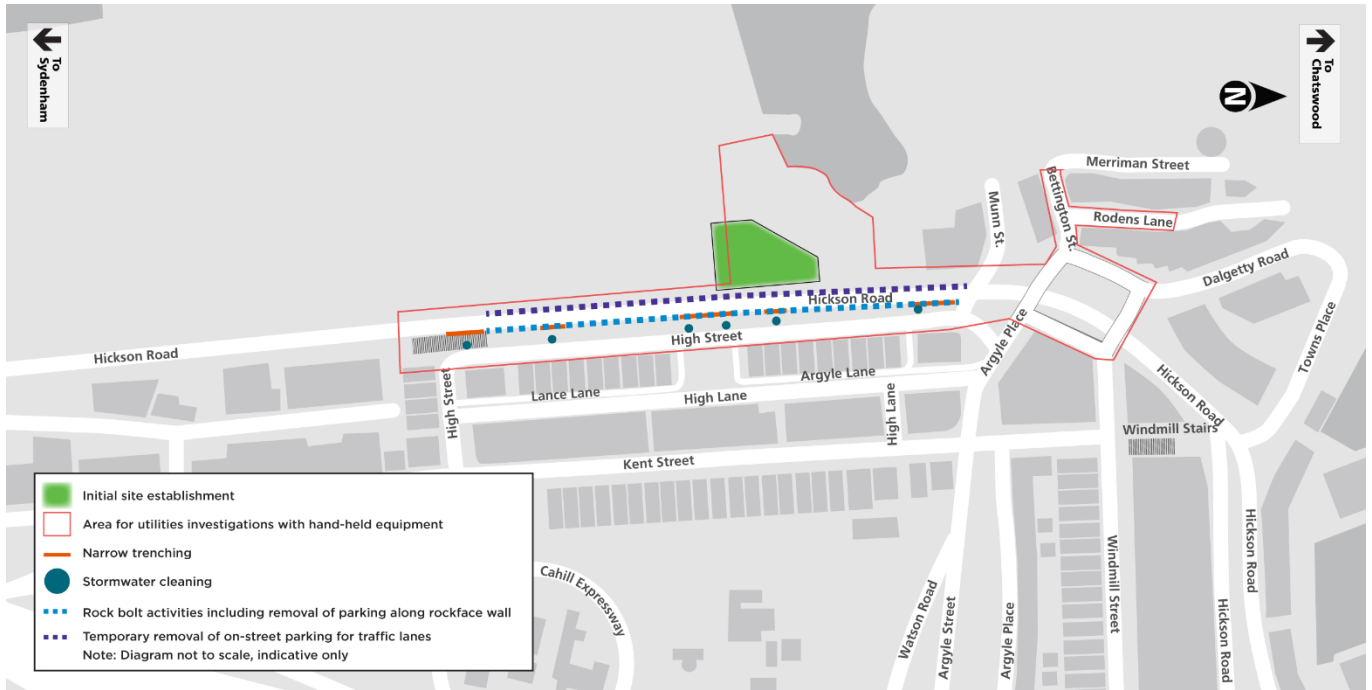
Standard work hours for the Barangaroo site are **Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm and Saturday between 8am and 1pm**. Due to high daytime traffic volumes and to ensure pedestrian safety, some works are also planned for outside of these times.

Hickson Road (between Munn Street and High Street steps)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Utility and geotechnical investigations to determine underground utilities involving narrow trenching on footpaths and roads</li> <li>• Utility and geotechnical investigations using hand held equipment to determine underground utilities</li> <li>• Site establishment within the open space area and adjacent to the rock face along Hickson Road</li> <li>• Installing bolts to protect and secure the rock face along Hickson Road before the start of excavation and road works</li> <li>• Removing vegetation and on-street parking to allow rock bolting to proceed</li> <li>• Relocating pedestrian paths to provide a safe work zone</li> </ul>
High Street	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Stormwater pit cleaning with vaccum trucks</li> </ul>
Hickson Road, High Street and Bettington Street	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Utility investigations to determine underground utilities using hand held equipment and opening lids to underground pits</li> </ul>
Location	Out-of-hours works
	The following works will occur on <b>Monday to Friday between 7pm and 7am throughout October</b> .
Hickson Road (between Munn Street and High Street steps)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Utility and geotechnical investigations and the relocation of services will take place on approximately <b>five nights over a two week period</b>, involving surveys and pit openings and requiring the use of a vaccum truck</li> </ul>

## What to expect

- There will be intermittent periods of noisy works. The project team will limit these impacts wherever possible by reducing the number of machines operating at the same time and turning off equipment when not in use.
- Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used and workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
- Increased light vehicle and truck movements.
- Temporary traffic and pedestrian changes will be required including lane and footpath closures around the site.
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and the community.
- Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
