September 2012 Air Quality Summary Report

Barangaroo South

This report has been compiled to summarise results of air quality monitoring at Barangaroo South in September 2012 in accordance with [EPL number 13336](#). This data is for samples taken from 1 to 30 September 2012. The data was provided to the Barangaroo Delivery Authority (the Licencee) on 24 October 2012.

Lend Lease conducts continuous air quality monitoring at Barangaroo South to measure air quality and assist the construction team implement appropriate environmental controls on site.

Air quality monitoring is carried out in accordance with all relevant authority and statutory requirements. Monitoring parameters include lead, metallic compounds, polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, total solid particles, particulate matter less than 10 microns (PM10), and volatile organic compounds.

Location of ambient air quality monitors

Ambient air quality monitoring devices are located at four locations around the site as shown below:



Approximate locations of air monitoring equipment

These locations correspond to the following licenced monitoring locations:

- Northern: EPL Point 5
- Eastern: EPL Point 8
- Southern: EPL Point 13
- Water Treatment Plant Air Quality: EPL Point 17

EPL Points 14, 15 & 16 have not been monitored to date, as they are associated with works that have not commenced.

August monitoring results – air quality

During September there was one PM10 guideline level exceedence, and two VOC trigger level exceedences. All other air parameters were within guideline or trigger levels. Construction activities were undertaken in accordance with relevant management plans. General controls implemented during this reporting period included:

- Water cart spraying and road sweeping.
- Covering loads and stockpiles as appropriate.
- Housekeeping to keep exposed areas to a minimum.
- Ongoing monitoring of the air and odour quality.

The total suspended particles annual rolling average is below the annual goal and is trending downward.
