BARANGAROO WORKSHOPS TO BE HELD ACROSS SYDNEY

Public engagement continues in Sydney's CBD, West and South

24 April 2010

Sydney's CBD, Parramatta and Caringbah will host the next stage of community engagement for the entire Barangaroo site, including the landmark Headland Park.

The workshops announced by the Barangaroo Delivery Authority build on the significant community involvement activities which have already seen thousands of people view what's planned for Sydney's newest precinct.

The workshops will provide a unique opportunity for the public from all over Sydney, to contribute to and help shape the 22ha site.

"I am very pleased we are taking Barangaroo to the people of Sydney whether they are in the CBD, the City's West or South", said John Tabart, CEO of the Barangaroo Delivery Authority.

"In the future people will come from all over the city to Barangaroo - this is our chance to find out exactly what they want to see and experience when they get there.

"We want people from all over the city to contribute their ideas, thoughts and suggestions to how we can weave Barangaroo into the existing fabric of Sydney.

"That's why we are taking these workshops to not only the CBD but also to the South and West to listen to people, where they live.

"We expect to have more workshops in Sydney's North and other locations around the city and even beyond, in coming months.

"And importantly, if people are unable to attend the workshops they can contribute 24 hours a day from next week when we launch our 'Online Forum'.

"The workshops follow on from the success of the Barangaroo Public Display which has seen more than 3000 people visit with some 250 providing written comment.

"This has been an incredibly valuable opportunity for the Barangaroo Delivery Authority to hear first hand the ideas, thoughts and suggestions of people to the project.

"This series of workshops builds on that process, as we seek contributions on all of Barangaroo including the Headland Park, Barangaroo Central and Barangaroo South.

"We are looking for the public to contribute to the real detail of Barangaroo and how we can ensure that Sydney's newest 'precinct', melds and connects with the existing city.

“Barangaroo will be successful if it reflects the desires of the people who will ultimately use it; the public.

“That is why we are taking Barangaroo into the heart of Sydney so we can harness the knowledge, passion and ideas of the people of this city”, he said.
