BARANGAROO INTEGRATED TRANSPORT PLAN RELEASED

The Barangaroo Delivery Authority today released the Barangaroo Integrated Transport Plan, which outlines a range of transport actions for the first occupancy in Barangaroo currently expected in 2015.

A Taskforce, led by Transport for NSW, developed the plan.

Members of the Taskforce included the Director General of Transport for NSW and representatives from the Department of Planning and Infrastructure, Department of Premier and Cabinet, Infrastructure New South Wales, the Barangaroo Delivery Authority, City of Sydney and Lend Lease.

The Plan intends to satisfy the first occupancy of Barangaroo, as well as longer term initiatives taking into account the ongoing growth across the Northern CBD.

The Plan recommends that short term initiatives and detailed planning for longer term initiatives should commence immediately.

This is another step in the implementation of the recommendations of the Sussex/Penn Review, which noted that *coordinated action is required to ensure the transport plans are put in place to meet the needs of Barangaroo commuters.*
