Thank you for your continued patience as we build the new waterfront of Sydney' CBD and for supporting many of the fabulous events we have held at Barangaroo and the Cutaway.

We are committed to keeping you informed of upcoming construction activities and events management activities at Barangaroo.

Blak Markets returns to Stargazer Lawn in Barangaroo Reserve on **Sunday, 2 July 2017**.

Taking place at the beginning of NAIDOC Week, the family-friendly event will be a vibrant celebration of Australia's rich Aboriginal culture including Barangaroo's first National Aboriginal Art Market, market stalls, food and free entertainment **from 11.00am to 5.00pm**.

The markets will feature bush tucker stalls, cooking demonstrations, free workshops and demonstrations including Tjanpi Weaving, Aboriginal language and traditional painting, live performances by Marcus Corowa, Jessie Lloyd with Emma Donovan and Fresh Water, free Cultural Tours of Barangaroo Reserve and traditional Aboriginal dance performances.

What you can expect

- Although we anticipate that the live entertainment and performances will increase noise in the area, levels will be within noise guidelines.
- A vehicle loading zone will be in place during site set-up and pack down along Bettington Street for the following times:
 - Friday, 30 June from 7:00am to 9:00am
 - Saturday, 1 July from 7:00am to 12:00pm
 - Monday, 3 July from 7:00am to 12:00pm

This area will be managed by traffic controllers, however there may be delayed access to/from Merriman Street during these times.

- Two parking bays on Merriman Street will be used by stall holders on Sunday, 2 July from 7:00am to 8:00pm.
- Two traffic controllers will be located at the Hickson Road pedestrian crossing on Sunday, 2 July from 11:00am to 3:00pm to assist the flow of pedestrians and traffic to ensure there are no long delays along Hickson Road.

Work Hours

- Site set-up activities will take place at the following times:
 - Friday, 30 June from 7:00am to 5:00pm
 - Saturday, 1 July from 7:00am to 5:00pm
 - Sunday, 2 July from 6:00am to 11:00am
- Pack down activities will take place at the following times:
 - Sunday, 2 July from 5:00pm to 8:00pm
 - Monday, 3 July from 7:00am to 12:00pm
