



## Modification work at Barangaroo Wharf

In planning for Tomorrow's Sydney we have built a new wharf at Barangaroo, increasing Sydney's ferry capacity and servicing the thousands of residents, visitors and workers travelling to and from the Barangaroo commercial and residential district.

### What we're doing at Barangaroo

#### Out of hours work

#### From Monday 29 January – Friday 23 February 2018

Some work activities will be undertaken from **Monday 29 January to Friday 23 February 2018 over a number of nights for a four-week period from 9pm-6am each night**. This involves the reinstallation of layover pontoons on wharves 1 and 2 which were removed in October 2017 to allow for modifications to improve operator safety.

Equipment to be used includes a silenced generator on a crane barge, angle grinders and other hand and power tools. The hand and power tool work will involve short durations of hammering and grinding. Every effort will be made to keep noise levels to a minimum while this important work is being undertaken.
