

IMPORTANT ROAD CLOSURE & CLEARWAY INFORMATION

Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games Queen's Baton Relay - Sydney CBD Saturday 3 February 2018

Dear resident/business owner,

The Queen's Baton Relay will pass through 28 locations in NSW between 28 January and 6 February 2018. Get involved while the baton is in Sydney CBD on Saturday 3 February. See it pass through the city along the Harbour foreshore starting from 3pm at Government House in the Royal Botanic Gardens travelling through The Rocks and Barangaroo Reserve to finish at Pirrama Park in Pyrmont for a *Shared Celebration* from 5:30pm to 6:30pm.

Roads along the harbour from the Sydney CBD to Pyrmont will be progressively closed and reopened as the relay travels along its course between 2:30pm and 6:30pm.

Please note: vehicles are not permitted to drive on, enter or exit a closed road from a driveway or car park. Access to your property and/or parking will be restricted while closures and clearways are in place. Access will be permitted at the discretion of NSW Police; otherwise there will be no access until roads have been safely reopened.

Road closures:

Sydney CBD closures between 2:30pm and 3:30pm

- Macquarie St from Bridge St to Sydney Opera House roundabout, including Albert St and The Conservatorium Rd off-ramp from the Cahill Expressway.

The Rocks and Dawes Point closures between 3pm to 4pm

- George St between Essex St and Hickson Rd.
- Hickson Rd between George St and Pottinger St.

Millers Point, Barangaroo and King St Wharf closures from 3pm to 4:30pm

- Towns Place and Dalgety Rd from Hickson Rd to Windmill St.
- Hickson Rd between Pottinger St and Napoleon St.
- Barangaroo Ave/Lime St between Watermans Quay and King St.
- Erskine St between Shelley St and Lime St.
- Erskine St between Sussex St and Shelley St (westbound only) – no access into King St Wharf from Erskine St, access via Wheat Rd only.
- King St between Shelley St and Lime St.
- Watermans Quay, Cuthbert St and a section Shelley St will also close.

Pyrmont closures between 4:45pm and 6:30pm

- Pirrama Rd and Murray St from Union St to Harris St – no access to The Star car park from Pirrama Rd
- Pirrama Rd between Jones Bay Rd and Harris St – access across the roundabout between Jones Bay Rd and Darling Island Rd will be maintained.

Special event clearways

Special event clearway parking restrictions are strict 'no parking' zones, even for local residents or mobility scheme permit holders.

Clearways will be in place along the event course at the following locations and times:

- **Sydney CBD** on Macquarie St north of Bridge St from midday until 3:30pm
- **The Rocks and Dawes Point** on George St from Alfred St to Hickson Rd, Hickson Rd to Pottinger St and Towns Pl between midday and 4:30pm.
- **Pyrmont** on sections of Pirrama Rd/Murray St from Union St to Pirrama Park between 3pm and 6:30pm.



Check signs carefully as vehicles left in signposted clearways will be towed and a fee applies. If your vehicle is towed you can call the Traffic Information Line on 132 701 to find its new location.
