

NOTIFICATION – BARANGAROO | 12 FEBRUARY 2018

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services start in 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024. Sydney Metro includes new CBD railway stations underground at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms under Central.

In 2024, Sydney Metro will have 31 stations on a new 66km rail system – the biggest urban rail project in Australian history. Sydney Metro will have ultimate capacity for a train every two minutes in each direction under the CBD.

John Holland CPB Ghella Joint Venture (JHCPBG) has been awarded the \$2.81 billion contract to build the twin railway tunnels from Chatswood to Sydenham and excavate six new Sydney Metro stations.

Out-of-hours works – Barangaroo Station site

Out-of-hours works to relocate utilities will continue from **Monday 19 February to Monday 5 March 2018**, weather and site conditions permitting (see map overleaf).

Location	Works
Hickson Road (between Munn Street and Windmill Street overpass)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Installing a temporary worksite in the median strip on Hickson Road Removing and painting road line markings
Hickson Road (between Munn Street and High Steps)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Electrical utility relocations, involving excavating, pipe laying and temporary road restoration
Corner of Sussex and Erskine streets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Electrical utility relocations, involving excavating, pipe laying and temporary road restoration

Works will involve:

- Establishing worksites, including safety and environmental controls
- Delivering plant and equipment
- Using jack hammers, saw cutters, vacuum trucks, excavators and compactors
- Laying pipes and conduits
- Reinstating any excavated areas and demobilising the temporary worksites.

Work hours

Due to high daytime traffic volumes and to ensure pedestrian safety, these works will be completed between **6pm and 7am Monday to Friday**. Out-of-hours works will occur on a maximum of three nights per week in a particular location, with a maximum of 10 nights per month.

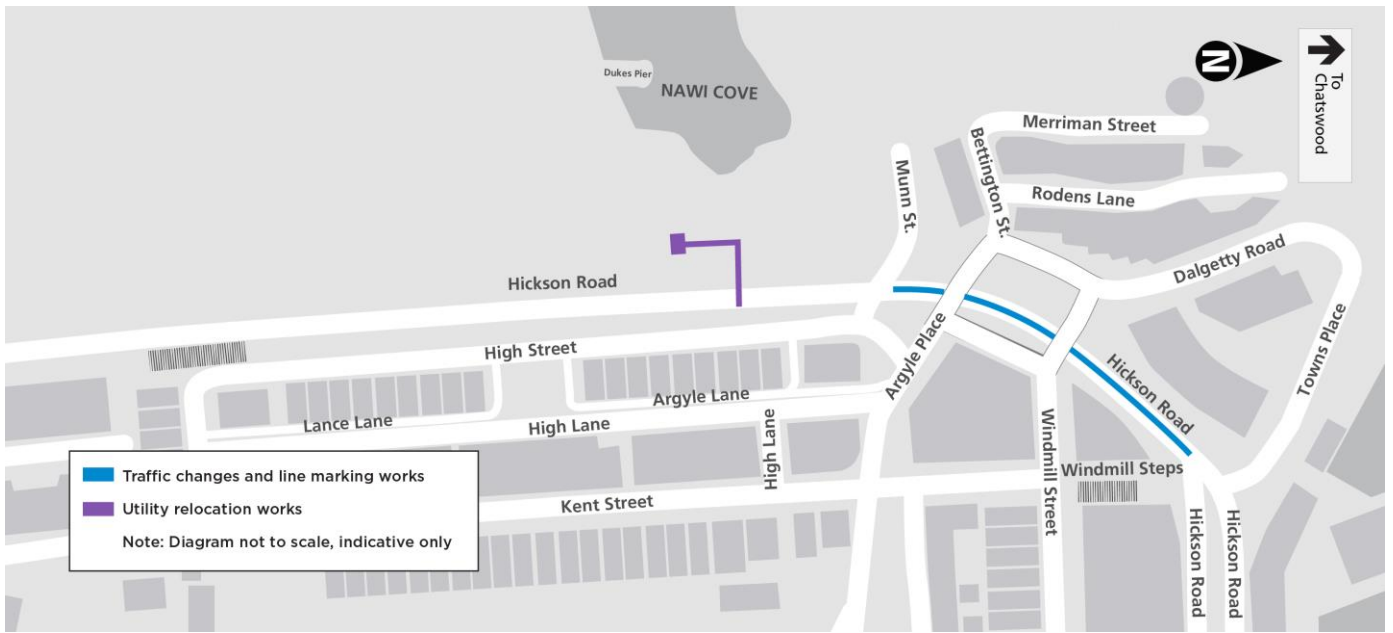
What to expect

- Due to the nature of the works, some activities will be noisy. High noise activities such as saw cutting and hammering will be completed before midnight.
- Temporary lane closures will be in place on Hickson Road and Sussex Street while works are carried out. Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers and motorists.
- Access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times.
