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Background

This Pollution Incident Response Management Plan has been developed and made publicly available in accordance with Part 3A Clause 98D(2) & 98D(3) of the Protection of the Environment Operations (General) Regulation 2009 for Environmental Protection Licence (EPL) 13336.

Lendlease implements a number of management plans to minimise or prevent any risk of harm to human health or the environment arising out of construction activities.

Lendlease Notification

All incidents and emergencies during the construction phase of the project will be managed in accordance with the Lendlease Barangaroo South *Emergency Response Plan*.

If an incident or emergency is determined to have caused or threatened material harm to the environment, Lendlease will immediately contact each authority as outlined below.

Ongoing communication following the initial notification may be undertaken by the BDA or Lendlease.

Risk Assessment

The likelihood of any environmental hazards are identified in the project *Impacts and Hazards Risk Assessment*.

Hazardous Substances

The site is an operational construction zone and includes the storage of chemicals (e.g. diesel, oxyacetylene and LPG). These chemicals are stored in accordance with the *Hazardous Substances & Dangerous Goods Plan*. The quantities of chemicals being stored onsite are located on the *Hazardous Substances Register*. The location of the chemicals is listed on the *Hazardous Substances Register* and *Hazardous Material Storage Location* figure.

Sediment Controls

The site is located adjacent to Darling Harbour. There are a number of measures in place to ensure that potential pollution from the site is minimised. The controls and locations of stormwater drains are located on the *Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan*.

Training

Training into this Plan is managed in accordance with the Lendlease Barangaroo South *Emergency Response Plan*.

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Community Notification

Barangaroo South manages its engagement with the local community through the *Community and Stakeholder Engagement Strategy*.

Engagement with the local community is regularly undertaken via consultative committees that have been established in conjunction with the Barangaroo Delivery Authority. These include the Community Construction Liaison Group and Business Construction Liaison Group.

In the case of an incident that requires immediate notification to the local community, this would be undertaken via personal consultation in the form of doorknocking and/or verbal communication via the telephone. For an incident that still requires notification, however, is not time critical, this would be done via letterbox drops, newsletters, advertising or via the project website.

Lendlease also operates an SMS service, which is available to the local business groups and supplies them with any emergency information.
