



# Barangaroo Remediation

## Hickson Road – Upcoming out of hours works and road closure

As previously notified, excavation within the Hickson Road Odour Control Enclosure (OCE) is now complete. Works to demobilise the site are progressing well.

The next phase of works includes removing the overhead duct bridge across Hickson Road at the north end of the works compound. Due to the nature of these works and to ensure the safety of the local community, the overhead duct bridge removal must take place at night when there is limited vehicular and pedestrian activity in the area.

The work will take one night to complete and will take place from **7pm on Sunday 13 October to 5am on Monday 14 October 2019**. The works area on Hickson Road will be impacted as follows:

- From 7pm to midnight – one lane (either northbound or southbound depending on the section of the overhead duct being removed) will be closed at any one time. Two-way traffic will be maintained during this period.
- From midnight until 5am – a full road closure of a small section of Hickson Road around the works compound, will be in place. Please refer to the diversion details and map below for more information.

A mobile crane will be used to remove the overhead duct bridge. There may be some noise associated with the use of generators and plant whilst the works take place.

### Diversion during the road closure

The road closure will be in place from Watermans Quay to the northern end of 30 Hickson Road (see map below). Traffic controllers and advanced warning signage will be in place to help direct road users.


Northbound traffic will be detoured via Napoleon Street to Kent Street to continue their journey and southbound traffic will be detoured via Walsh Bay to Kent Street.

Access to the driveways for 30 and 38 Hickson Road will be maintained and under traffic control.

### Contingency

If the works are unable to take place on Sunday 13 October, they will commence on either Sunday 20 October or Sunday 27 October 2019. The timing and road impacts will remain the same as above.
