Thank you for your continued support for the events we have held at Barangaroo and the Reserve throughout 2019.

This letter is to inform you that Barangaroo Reserve will be hosting Sydney Festival in 2020 with the installation of Proclamation from Wednesday 8 January to Sunday 26 January.

Proclamation is a large-scale art installation at Barangaroo Reserve, flying 250 flags that explore Australians' diverse ideas about land and country, belonging and possession

We will also be hosting The Vigil in conjunction with Sydney Festival from 8pm Saturday 25 January to 6am Sunday 26 January.

The Vigil offers an opportunity to gather campfire-side and experience a night of performance and reflection on the eve of Australia Day. Hear live music and guests alongside choral and poetry performances, and experience the resilience, beauty and joy of First Nations culture.

What you can expect

- Noise associated with sound testing, live entertainment, performances and the operation of catering equipment.
- There will be increased activity and vehicle movements in the Reserve and surrounding areas during set up and pack down.
- Towns Place and Merriman Street will be used for unloading/loading during set up and pack down. Traffic controllers will be in place at the appropriate times.

Work hours

- Site set-up activities for Proclamation will take place from Friday 3 to Wednesday 8 January 2020 between 7am – 7pm.
- Site set-up activities for the Vigil will take place from Wednesday 22 to Saturday 25 January 2020 between 7am – 7pm.
- Technical rehearsals and sound testing for the Vigil will take place on Friday 24 January 2020.
- Pack down activities for both events will be carried out Tuesday 28 and Wednesday 29 January 2020.
